

An Enduring Artistic Journey: The Full Biography of Peter Knapp

Art has been Peter Knapp's lifelong companion, a constant calling that shaped his path. While the demands of family and financial responsibilities initially meant his dream of a full-time fine art career remained unrealized, his dedication to creative expression never wavered.

Knapp's artistic journey began early, culminating in a Bachelor of Arts (BA), Cum Laude from the University of Massachusetts in 1972. His early work showcased a strong foundation in **woodcuts and drawings**, alongside acrylic and oil painting. The mid-1970s saw his nascent career flourish, with his work accepted into **prestigious juried shows** across the Northeast, including the **Boston Printmakers 27th Annual Exhibition at the Boston Museum of Fine Arts in February 1975**, a significant feather in his cap. Other notable early exhibitions included the Berkshire Art Association Exhibition and the Springfield Art League National Exhibition. This period also included a two-person show, "Wood," with John Michael Garber, at Leverett Craftsmen and Artists in March 1976.

However, a period of disillusionment, youthful existential despair, and the increasing managerial demands of his furniture business job led to a hiatus from active art creation after 1976. Yet, the call of art was too strong to ignore.

In the 1990s, Peter returned with full fervor to his passion for art. Despite the challenges of being newly married with two young daughters and facing organizational issues at his furniture business, he again pursued exhibitions with determination. The mid-1990s brought further recognition, with acceptances into significant national juried shows such as "Printwork '95" at Dutchess County Art Association/Barrett House Galleries (Juried by Andrea Feldman, Assistant Curator, MoMA, NYC), and "Art on Paper 1995" at The Maryland Federation of Art (Juried by Frank Gettings, Curator of Prints and Drawings, Hirshhorn Museum). He also notably received awards from the Springfield Art League and 2nd in Show at the 9th Annual Klamath Juried Open 1994. These achievements solidified his resolve, even as his professional life took another turn.

The mid-1990s saw the furniture business sold, demanding Peter's complete commitment and long hours from its new owners. Over a decade later, faced with the choice to buy the business or seek new employment following a family tragedy within the ownership, Peter courageously acquired the company, renaming it Danco Modern. This period, and his eventual pivot, was notably highlighted in an <u>article appearing in the Daily Hampshire Gazette (March 5, 2022) and the Greenfield Recorder (March 9, 2022)</u>, chronicling his resilience and unwavering dedication.

In his 60s, a series of health challenges served as a profound turning point. Illness took a toll on his mind and body, but paradoxically, **art became his salvation**. This healing path evolved to encompass broader themes—issues in the community, the world, and the universe, all within



and subservient to nature and humanity's place in it. With the unwavering support of his family, Peter now dedicates himself to art full-time.

His current mixed media process seamlessly incorporates elements from **painting**, **drawing**, **and woodcut printmaking**. When immersed in a project, Peter embraces experimentation, invention, and risk-taking, constantly seeking solutions to creative challenges. He believes in continuous improvement and innovation, a philosophy influenced by artists like Hyman Bloom. Titles often serve as foundational guidelines for his explorations. His work exists on a "bridge of continuity," developing ideas and techniques based on ongoing learning, past successes, and a desire to enrich both conceptual and physical creative skills.

Peter's studio work in Sunderland focuses on mixed media, utilizing a diverse palette of acrylic paints, inks, mediums, and fixatives on gesso-primed hardboard panels. He has also revived his woodcut printmaking, producing numerous editions at First Proof Press in Brattleboro, Vermont, expanding his overall portfolio.

Since 2020, Peter's prolific output has led to his participation in **over 40 exhibitions across the United States**. These include prestigious juried shows featuring selections by curators from major institutions such as **The Metropolitan Museum of Art (NYC)**, **the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum (NYC)**, **the Smithsonian American Art Museum, The Museum of Modern Art (NYC)**, and **the National Gallery of Art (Washington D.C.)**, alongside influential contemporary artists.

A testament to his enduring commitment and talent, Peter was accepted as a **full member of the prestigious Copley Society of Art (Co|So) in Boston** in September 2023. As the oldest non-profit arts association in the United States, Co|So represents a diverse range of artists. His recent acceptance into Co|So's 2025 National Show, "Expression Now: An Impressionist Approach," for his piece "At the Stroke of Midnight," further solidified his standing. This marks his **fifth consecutive juried acceptance in less than a year and a half at Co|So**, a remarkable feat that has earned him the distinguished status of **Copley Artist (CA)**, an honor celebrated with an award certificate at the opening reception on June 5th 2025.

Inspired by contemporary and modern artists such as Georgiana Houghton, Hyman Bloom, Jean-Michel Basquiat, and James Siena, among many others, Peter hopes his own body of work will encourage aspiring artists to cross creative boundaries. He extends gratitude to local artists Scott Prior, Will Sillin, and the late Greg Stone for their guidance and inspiration.

Peter Knapp's work is driven by a profound demand from his soul, aiming to create meaningful purpose through art and explore our existence within nature and the world we create. He is married to Jane and has two grown daughters, Elizabeth and Jillian.
